- DAY 1 Depart Reading and head for Williamsburg, VA where America began and history lives. After a lunch stop enroute, we will travel to Charles City to visit the Berkeley Plantation, the most historic plantation on the James River. Then we will continue to Williamsburg, where, after checking into the hotel, we will enjoy a delicious dinner at Captain George's Smorgasbord. Later, depart from Busch Gardens' Christmas Town Celebration, one of the largest light displays in North America. Special entertainment brings the holiday spirit to life this evening.
- DAY 2 Following breakfast, we will literally step back in time for a day while at Colonial Williamsburg on the eve of the American Revolution AND Christmas. Discover what it took to build a nation while experiencing a traditional holiday extravaganza featuring seasonal merriment. Visit the shops, public buildings and restored homes. Stay until dark to observe Williamsburg's Grand Illumination. Afterwards, we will visit the Celebration in Lights at Newport News Park, a two-mile drive-through of spectacular with over 700,000 lights and 200 animated scenes.
- **DAY 3** The **Virginia Living Museum** combines the elements of a native wildlife park, science museum, aquarium, botanical garden and planetarium all in one beautiful setting. Together we will enjoy the planetarium show **Star of Wonder**, depicting the Star of Bethlehem. Lunch again will be enroute as we make our way home filled with lasting memories of Williamsburg's Winter Wonderland.
