LOCKS, LAKES AND LEGENDS: FINGER LAKES, NY | TRIP ITINERARY

This sample itinerary described below is approximately like the itinerary your group will be following during your stay with the Berks History Center and WHITE STAR TOURS, however, the exact times, days, and destinations may vary.

DAY 1

Depart from the Fecera's Furniture (4710 Penn Avenue, Reading) and travel to New York's Finger lakes region with its shimmering lakes, world-changing engineering, sparkling wines, great food and stories past and present during the peak of fall foliage. Upon arrival you will stop for lunch in Watkins Glen (on your own) before your cruise on Seneca Lake. Later, you will arrive in Syracuse for dinner (included), followed by check-in at your hotel where lodging has been arranged for the next three nights.

DAY 2

Following breakfast (included), you will depart for a tour of the Erie Canal Museum which showcases the 1850 National Register Weighlock Building and tells the incredible adventure story of the Erie Canal. Board a full-size replica canal boat to explore life in a canal town, and experience part of history that played an imperative role in the growth and development of the United States. Afterwards, you will depart on a city tour of Syracuse. Later, arrive at Salt City Market for lunch on your own at one of the "Ten Best Food Halls Across the Country." In the afternoon you will enjoy a narrated cruise on the Erie Canal which will travel through a 100-year-old-lock. Your day will end with an evening of entertainment.

DAY 3

After breakfast (included), you will depart for the Seward House, home of William H. Seward, Lincoln's Secretary of State during the Civil War, purchaser of Alaska, and friend of Harriet Tubman. Lunch has been arranged for you at the Sherwood Inn in picturesque Skanetetes. In the afternoon, you will tour Strawberry Fields & Florist, a hypnotic strawberry farm. Later, stop at Anyela's Vineyards for a tasting of their wines.

DAY 4

Enjoy breakfast (included), then check out and depart for a visit to the Watkins Glen Gorge Trail, where within two miles, the glen's steam descends 400 feet past 200-foot cliffs, generating 19 waterfalls along its course. Afterwards, depart for home with a lunch stop (on your own) and memories of "Lock, Lakes & Legends!"
